

Advantages / disadvantages of the EU membership of Slovakia









Advantages of Slovakia's EU membership – according to party preference




















Policies: national jurisdiction








Rule enforcement by the European Union






Significance of the European elections



What significance do you personally attach to the European elections in May? According to party preference (Very big / big significance)











Numbers in percent | Deviations of 100% are due to rounding Basic population: eligible voters from 18 years in Slovakia








Approval of EU enlargement according to member countries








