EU turning 60: Will it get a second wind?

Background

On March 1st, the European Commission published the White Paper in which the President of the European Commission Jean-Claude Juncker outlined five possible scenarios for further development of the EU until 2025.

“White Paper on the future of the EU” points out at a wide range of options for the future of Europe of 27 member states and is meant as an input for the discussion of leaders at the Rome summit to be held on March 25th. The meeting will commemorate the 60th anniversary of the Treaties of Rome of 1957 and should complete the so-called “Bratislava Process”. The Rome declaration should become a political manifesto for the next stage of European integration.

What is the Slovak take on the White Paper? Can Slovakia embrace one of the scenarios or do we have our own ideas? Is Slovakia ready to give up on some of the common ambitions? What could “less EU” and the greater use of multiple speeds mean for Slovakia?
